This application is an application for a seasonal water assignment under the section 127 Water Act 2000.

The Seller warrants:

- It is the holder of a water allocation which is permitted to be seasonally assigned under the Water Plan (Fitzroy Basin) 2011 to a location in the Emerald Channel Scheme,
- Is a party to a bulk water contract with Sunwater for the supply of the water the subject of this seasonal water assignment,
- It has available to it the Nominated Transfer Volume in the relevant water year under its allocation(s) for the proposed seasonal water assignment.

The Seller indemnifies FIN against any loss, claim, damage or liability caused or contributed to by a breach of the warranties set out above by the Seller.

The Buyer warrants:

- That it is either a party to the FIN Standard Customer Contract or another customer contract with FIN (Customer Contract),
- It is authorised to take water from the Customer Offtake Works.

The Buyer agrees that Customer Maximum Allocation under its Customer Contract for the relevant water year is increased by the Nominated Transfer Volume under this seasonal water assignment.

These terms to the extent they apply to the Buyer are incorporated into the Buyer's Customer Contract and a breach of these terms by the Buyer will be a breach of its Customer Contract.

This form must be signed by both the Buyer and the Seller who must be the persons or entities holding the relevant water allocation or listed on the Customer Contracts (Relevant Signatories). FIN will accept electronic signatures from each Relevant Signatory.

1. What is a temporary transfer

A temporary transfer enables two customers to transfer available water in the current water year.

The seller's remaining available water for the water year will be reduced by the Nominated Transfer Volume. The water available to the buyer will be increased by this volume, less any Loss Adjustment (the Assessed Volume).

The volume available to the buyer is not affected by any increases in Announced Allocation during the water year.

Temporary transfers do not alter the buyer or seller's access conditions for taking water from a channel or pipeline.

2. Volume that can be transferred

The maximum amount the seller may transfer is the volume available to the seller on their water account at the time of application. By signing this form, the seller warrants they have sufficient water available for the temporary transfer. The Seller is encouraged to check their meter reading to determine if such water is available. Contact FIN for an up to date water account balance.

If the Seller applies to transfer more than their available water, they will be in breach of their supply contract with FIN.

3. Application

To apply for a transfer, both the buyer and seller should complete and sign this application form and submit it either by Email or Mail as per the details above.

End of Water Year applications - Please ensure the application form is submitted at least five (5) business days prior to the end of the current water year.

FIN will notify the seller within 5 business days of receiving all applications (correctly completed) whether the temporary transfer has been approved or refused. The rules applied by SunWater in determining whether to approve or refuse a temporary transfer can be found in the Local Conditions, specific to each water supply scheme. A copy of the current Local Conditions can be obtained by contacting SunWater or from www.sunwater.com.au

WARNING

- Any transfer of money between the buyer and the seller is made at their own risk.
- The buyer should not begin accessing the water from a temporary transfer until they receive the written confirmation from SunWater that the temporary transfer has been approved. If a buyer exceeds its existing entitlement and the temporary transfer is refused, SunWater is required to report the buyer to the Department of Natural Resources and Mines.
- Customer should be aware that any temporary transfer undertaken in conjunction with a Carryover application is subject to the Carryover Cancellation rules for that Scheme.

5. Supply Contract

The buyer must have a Supply Contract with SunWater for delivery of the water prior to the application being made. To accelerate the processing of this form, please ensure all accounts are current. Where the seller may have an arrangement with FIN for payment of outstanding charges, FIN may approve the transfer subject to these proceeds being paid to FIN Water to reduce the outstanding amount. You can check your balance by contacting FIN.

6. Transfer Adjustment Fee

Refer to Local Conditions specific to each water supply scheme.

7. Approved of Pumps

The buyer must ensure they have obtained approval for their pump. This may include prior approval under a license.

8. Loss Adjustments

Refer to Local Conditions specific to each water supply scheme. Integrated Planning Act for their pump. This may include prior approval under a license.
