Transfer Statement

This application is made under the Fairbairn Irrigation Network Limited (FIN) Standard Customer Contract made under section 738I of the Water Act and is an application for a seasonal water assignment under the section 127 Water Act 2000.

The Seller warrants: that it is a party to the FIN Standard Customer Contract (Customer Contract) and holds a water allocation in the Emerald Irrigation Scheme, and it has sufficient water available in the relevant water year under its allocation(s) for the proposed seasonal water assignment of the Nominated Transfer Volume.

The Seller agrees to reduce the Customer Maximum Allocation under its Customer Contract for the relevant water year, by the Nominated Transfer Volume made available to the Buyer under the seasonal water assignment.

The Buyer warrants: That it is either a party to the FIN Standard Customer Contract or another customer contract with FIN (Customer Contract), and It is authorised to take water from the Customer Offtake Works.

The Buyer agrees that Customer Maximum Allocation under its Customer Contract for the relevant water year is increased by the Nominated Transfer Volume under this seasonal water assignment. The Buyer acknowledges that the seasonal water assignment is subject to the Distribution Fixed Charges under the Customer Contract. The terms of this seasonal water assignment are incorporated into each Customer Contract and a breach of these terms by either the Buyer or the Seller will be a breach of its Customer Contract.

This form must be signed by ALL those listed as Customers on the Customer Contracts and listed as holders of the Water Allocation (Relevant Signatories). FIN will accept electronic signatures from each Relevant Signatory.

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1. What is a intra system temporary transfer

An intra system temporary transfer enables two customers of FIN to transfer available water in the current water year through Fairbairn Irrigation Network Ltd account management system and does not involve Sunwater. The seller's remaining available water for the water year will be reduced by the Nominated Transfer Volume. The water available to the buyer will be increased by this volume. The volume available to the buyer is not affected by any increases in Announced Allocation during the water year. Temporary transfers do not alter the buyer or seller's access conditions for taking water from a channel or pipeline.

2. Volume that can be transferred

The maximum amount the seller may transfer is the volume available to the seller on their water account at the time of application. By signing this form, the seller warrants they have sufficient water available for the temporary transfer. The Seller is encouraged to check their meter reading to determine if such water is available. Available water balances can be obtained by contacting Fairbairn Irrigation Network Ltd office on 4982 4446 or email request to admin@fairbairnirrigation.com.au if the Seller applies to transfer more than their available water, they will be in breach of their supply contract with SunWater.

3. Application

To apply for a transfer, both the buyer and seller must complete and sign this application form and submit it either by Email or Mail as per the details above. End of Water Year applications - Please ensure the application form is submitted at least five (5) business days prior to the end of the current water year. Fairbairn Irrigation Network Ltd will notify the buyer and seller within 5 business days of receiving all applications (correctly completed) whether the temporary transfer has been approved or refused.
